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SUGGESTED TREATMENTS FOR SALIVARY HYPOFUNCTION

- Vitamin E softgel -- 400 IU 3 times a day Directions:
 - 1. Cut the top of the capsule open with scissor (or bite and chew).
 - 2. Squeeze into mouth (rub it all around if necessary).
 - **3.** Swish and spit out.
- Omega-3 fatty acid fish oil 1200 mg or Flaxseed oil -- 1000 mg 3 capsules
- Sonicare or Oral-B electric toothbrush -- use 3 times a day Directions:
 - 1. Place the head of toothbrush on <u>each</u> tooth for 10 seconds, front and back.
 - 2. Brush the tongue in strokes from back to front.
- Sugar-free 100% Xylitol gum and/or mints -- as needed (Amazon.com or Spry/Epic)
- **Prescription strength fluoride toothpaste --** (e.g., Prevident 5000)
- **MI Paste Plus** -- (topical cream with calcium and phosphate) Directions:
 - 1. Use before bed 30 minutes after prescription fluoride toothpaste.
 - 2. Put a pea-size amount on finger or Q-tip swab.
 - 3. Rub around teeth and all mucosa and tongue.
 - 4. Leave on and go to bed.
 - Line inside of dental mouth guard or bleaching tray, if accessible, for sleep.
- Humidifier -- Set at 50% in your bedroom.
- Olive oil as needed.

Directions:

- 1. Rub oil all around mucosa and tongue.
- Caphosol Rinse, NeutraSal, or baking soda Rinse 3 times a day. Directions:
 - 1. 1 tablespoon baking soda and 1 teaspoon salt in 8 ounces of water.
 - 2. Caphosol and NeutraSal Rinse—use as directed on box.

- Evoxac/Cevimeline or Salagen/Pilocarpine Hcl Titrate to maximum dosage (stimulates salivary glands/salivary flow).
 Directions:
 - 1. Start by taking 1 pill with food (breakfast) for 7 days.
 - 2. If this is tolerated well (no reactions, or if side effects are tolerable), increase dose to <u>2 pills a day</u> with meals for 7 days.
 - 3. If this is tolerated well, increase dose to <u>3 pills a day</u> with meals for 7 days.
 - If this is tolerated well, increase dose to <u>4 pills a day</u> with meals for 7 days. <u>This is the maximum dosage</u>. <u>Do not exceed 4 pills a day</u>. Continue at this dosage unless a reaction occurs.

*** If a reaction occurs, decrease dosage by 1 pill a day.

- **General Dentist** every 3 months for cleanings and any dental treatments.
- Fluoride Varnish every 3 months (can be done at your dental office). <u>Directions</u>:
 - 1. No drinking for 30 minutes after treatment
 - 2. No eating for 1 hour after treatment
 - 3. No brushing teeth until bedtime or at least 6 hours
